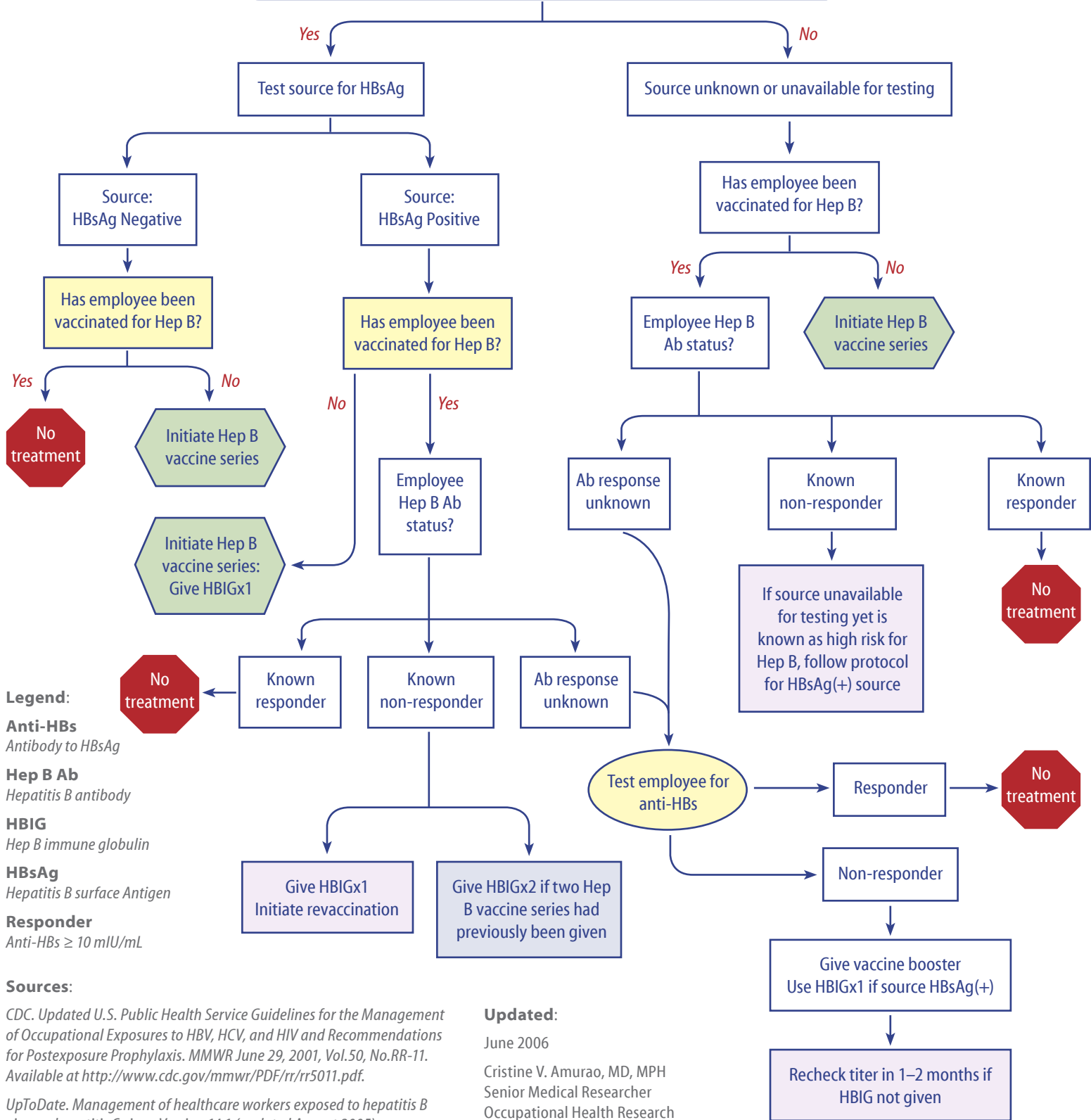


Determining Treatment for Hepatitis B Exposure
